Solution We continued to use the brand elements already in place as the foundation for the 2015 conference materials (conference logo, color palette, typestyles, etc.). Additionally we developed a new visual theme for this year's event and incorporated it into a conference program, registration materials, website banners, an awards event program, slideshow presentations, signage, name badges, and more.

**Result** AACOM has continued to tout its approval and excitement of the materials we developed for its annual meetings, which have further strengthened the identity and brand recognition of the events. 
